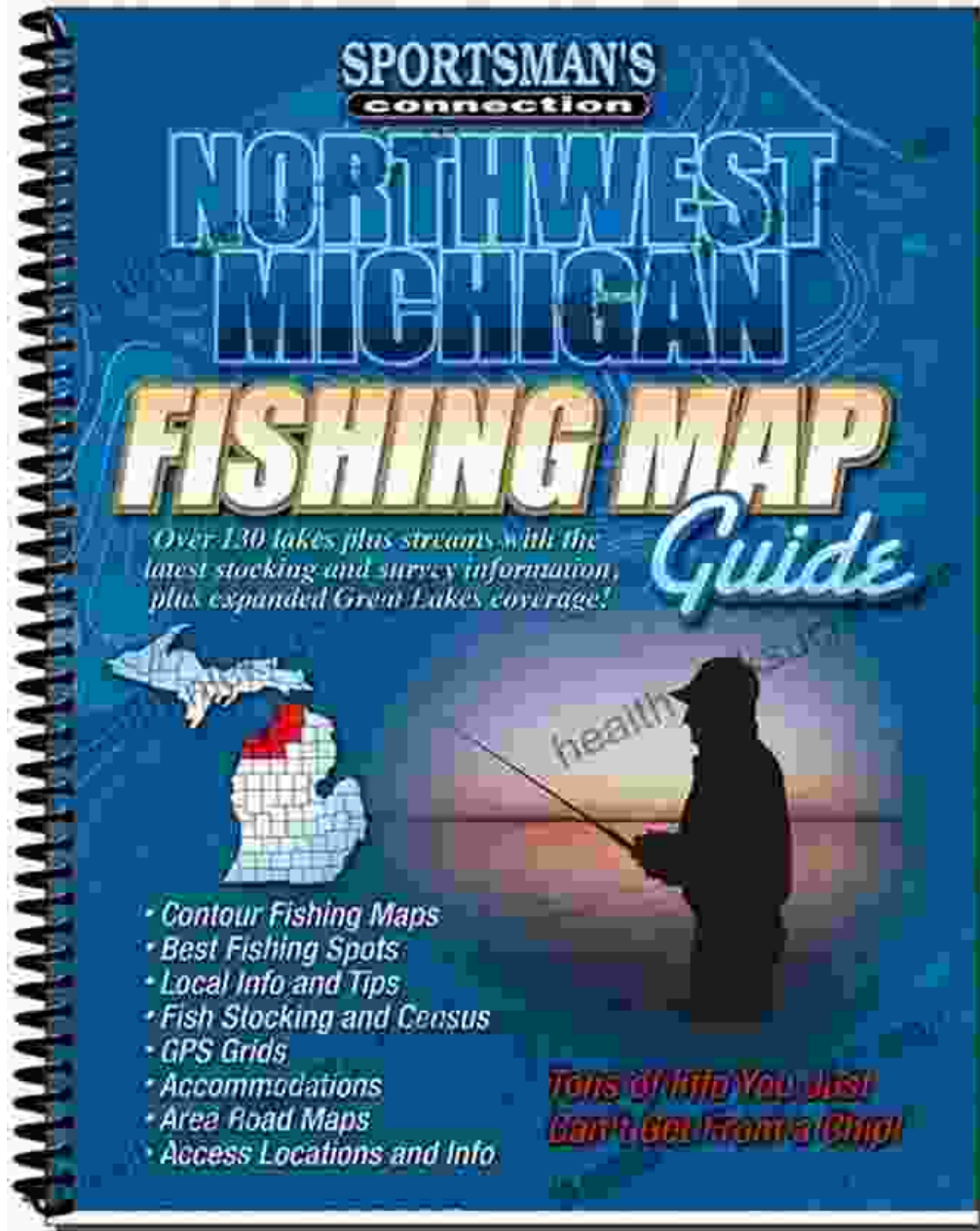
Best lakes: Elk Lake, Lake Bellaire, Wamplers Lake

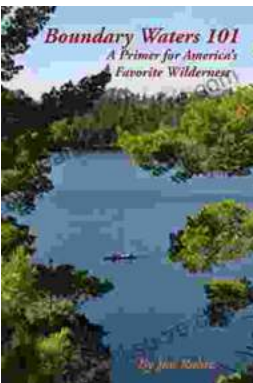
